Hadeeth Three

When Sayyiduna 'Ali (radhiyallahu 'anhu) would describe Rasulullah (sallallahu 'alaihi wasallam), he would say,

"Rasulullah (sallallahu 'alaihi wasallam) was not extra tall, nor very short.

He was of medium stature.

He neither had very curly hair, nor completely straight hair, rather he had slightly wavy hair.

He did not have a fat body not a round face, rather his (blessed) face was slightly rounded.

His complexion was white (fair), mixed with redness. His (blessed) eyes were extremely black and his eye lashes were (beautifully) long. The joints of his body and his shoulders were large (i.e. strong).

His (blessed) body was not hairy. He had a thin line of hair running from the chest to the navel. His palms and feet were fully fleshed.

When he walked, he lifted his legs, as if he is descending to a lower ground.

When he turned (towards someone), he turned fully.

Between his shoulders was the seal of prophethood, and he was the seal (last) of the Ambiyaa ('alaihimus salaam).


