



The Humility of Rasulullah (sallallahu 'alaihi wasallam)

Hadeeth One

عَنْ أَنَسِ بْنِ مَالِكٍ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ قَالَ : كَانَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ ﷺ يَعُودُ الْمَرِيضَ ، وَيَشْهَدُ الْجَنَازَةَ ، وَيَرْكَبُ
الْحِمَارَ ، وَيُجِيبُ دَعْوَةَ الْعَبْدِ ،

Sayyiduna Anas bin Maalik (radhiyallahu 'anhu) narrates that Rasulullah (sallallahu 'alaihi wasallam) would visit the sick, attend the janaazah, ride on a donkey, and accept the invitation of a slave.

وَكَانَ يَوْمَ بَنِي قُرَيْظَةَ عَلَى حِمَارٍ مَحْطُومٍ بِحَبْلِ مِنْ لَيْفٍ ، وَعَلَيْهِ إِكَافٌ مِنْ لَيْفٍ .

On the day of Banu Quraizah, Rasulullah (sallallahu 'alaihi wasallam) was mounted on a donkey, the reigns of which were made of date palm leaves.

On it was a saddle also made of date palm leaves.

Hadeeth Two

عَنْ أَنَسِ بْنِ مَالِكٍ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ قَالَ : كَانَ النَّبِيُّ ﷺ يُدْعَى إِلَى حُبْزِ الشَّعِيرِ وَالْإِهَالَةِ السَّنِيحَةِ
فَيُجِيبُ .

Sayyiduna Anas bin Maalik (radhiyallahu 'anhu) reports that Rasulullah (sallallahu 'alaihi wasallam) would be invited to (eat) barley bread and stale fat, and would accept (the invitation).

وَلَقَدْ كَانَتْ لَهُ دِرْعٌ عِنْدَ يَهُودِيٍّ ، فَمَا وَجَدَ مَا يَفْكُهَا حَتَّى مَاتَ .

He had pawned his armour to a Jew and did not possess wealth to release it until he passed away.
