



## The Character of Rasulullah (sallallahu 'alaihi wasallam)

### Hadeeth One

عَنْ أَنَسِ بْنِ مَالِكٍ رضي الله عنه قَالَ : خَدَمْتُ رَسُولَ اللَّهِ صلى الله عليه وسلم عَشْرَ سِنِينَ . فَمَا قَالَ لِي أُفٍّ قَطُّ ، وَمَا قَالَ لِي شَيْءٍ صَنَعْتُهُ لَمْ صَنَعْتَهُ ، وَلَا لِي شَيْءٍ تَرَكْتُهُ لَمْ تَرَكْتُهُ . وَكَانَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ صلى الله عليه وسلم مِنْ أَحْسَنِ النَّاسِ خُلُقًا ...

Sayyiduna Anas bin Maalik (radhiyallahu ‘anhu) says, “I served Rasulullah (sallallahu ‘alaihi wasallam) for ten years. He never said ‘uff’ to me and did not ask me why I did something that I was not supposed to do or why did I not do something that I was supposed to do. Rasulullah (sallallahu ‘alaihi wasallam) possessed the best character from all people...”

### Hadeeth Two

عَنْ عَائِشَةَ رضي الله عنها أَنَّهَا قَالَتْ : لَمْ يَكُنْ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ صلى الله عليه وسلم فَاحِشًا وَلَا مُتَفَحِّشًا ، وَلَا صَخَّابًا فِي الْأَسْوَاقِ ، وَلَا يَجْزِي بِالسَّيِّئَةِ السَّيِّئَةَ ، وَلَكِنْ يَعْفُو وَيَصْفَحُ .

Sayyidah ‘Aaishah (radhiyallahu ‘anha) say, “Rasulullah (sallallahu ‘alaihi wasallam) was not naturally obscene, nor did he conduct himself in an obscene manner. He would not scream in the market places and would not respond to evil with evil, rather he would forgive and overlook.”
